



How to reach UNI in Milan

We are in via Sannio, 2, 20137 Milan, Italy and here we give you some travel solutions to reach the UNI office in Milan, considering different means of transport.

If you arrive from Linate airport

Option 1 (metro only):

Metro M4 (blue line) + Metro M3 (yellow line) (estimated time: 45 minutes)





- 1. At the 'Linate Aeroporto' stop, take the metro M4 in the direction of 'San Cristoforo'.
- 2. Get off at the 'Sforza-Policlinico' stop.
- 3. Follow the signs to the M4 exit and direction M3 "Missori".
- 4. On the surface: walk along the tree-lined path next to the church, reach and walk the entire length of the Pantano street, then turn left (Velasca square) to the M3 'Missori' metro station.
- 5. Take the M3 metro at the 'Missori' stop in the direction of 'San Donato'.
- 6. Get off at the 'Lodi TIBB' stop.
- 7. Walk 80 metres to UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.

Option 2 (surface transport only):

Bus 973 + Tram 27 + Bus 92 (estimated time: 80 minutes)







- 1. Take bus line 973 in the direction of 'Piazza Ovidio'.
- 2. Get off at the 'Repetti M4' stop.
- 3. Take tram 27 in the direction of 'Fontana'.
- 4. Get off at the 'Piazza Emilia' stop.
- 5. Walk 100 metres (viale Umbria) and go to the 'Piazza Emilia' stop.
- 6. Take bus line 92 in the direction of 'Isonzo'.
- 7. Get off at the 'viale Umbria' stop (Lodi M3).
- 8. Walk 80 metres to UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.





If you arrive from Malpensa Airport

Option 1: Malpensa Express (train) + Metro (estimated time: 90 minutes)







- 1. Take the 'Malpensa Express' train (departure every 30 minutes, duration 40/50 minutes).
- 2. You can get off at the 'Cadorna FN' station or at the 'Centrale FS' station.

If you get off at Cadorna FN Station

- 1. Take the M1 metro (red line) in the direction of 'Sesto FS'.
- 2. Get off at the 'Duomo' stop.
- 3. Take the M3 metro (yellow line) towards 'San Donato'.
- 4. Get off at the 'Lodi TIBB' stop.
- 5. Walk 80 metres to UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.

If you get off at Centrale FS Station:

- 1. Take the M3 metro (yellow line) towards 'San Donato'.
- 2. Get off at 'Lodi TIBB'.
- 3. Walk 80 metres to the UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.

Option 2: Malpensa Shuttle (bus) + Metro (estimated time: approx. 90 minutes, depending on surface traffic)





- 1. Take the 'Malpensa Shuttle' bus (departure every 30 minutes, duration approximately 60 minutes).
- 2. Get off at 'Centrale FS' station.
- 3. Take the M3 metro (yellow line) towards 'San Donato'.
- 4. Get off at the 'Lodi TIBB' stop.
- 5. Walk 80 metres to UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.

- 1. Take the M1 metro (red line) in the direction of 'Sesto FS'.
- 2. Get off at the 'Duomo' stop.
- 3. Take the M3 metro (yellow line) towards 'San Donato'.
- 4. Get off at the 'Lodi TIBB' stop.
- 5. Walk 80 metres to UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.



If you arrive from the 'Centrale FS' railway station

- 1. Take the M3 metro (yellow line) towards 'San Donato'.
- 2. Get off at the 'Lodi TIBB' stop.
- 3. Walk 80 metres to the UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.



If you arrive from the 'Rogoredo FS' railway station

- 1. Take the M3 metro (yellow line) towards 'Comasina'.
- 2. Get off at the 'Lodi TIBB' stop.
- 3. Walk 80 metres to the UNI offices, Via Sannio, 2.
