## PRESENTATION

Combating climate change is a complex issue that, as of 2019, has found an answer in the European Green Deal, a package of policy initiatives in key sectors such as climate, energy, transport, and agriculture, which aims to achieve climate neutrality by 2050.

Strengthening the synergy between standardization and legislation by sharing climate change goals and strategies is a key step for both the European Commission and CEN representatives to deploy appropriate green policies and effective actions. Decisive, concrete and lasting results to address the climate crisis can only be achieved by taking coordinated measures.

This workshop responds to this need. Divided into two sessions, the meeting aims to provide cross-cutting expertise to both legislators and regulators.
