Adopt one of the solutions already foreseen by the current European Standardisation System, such as previous standards, technical specifications, or interim solutions, ensuring transparency and stakeholder involvement. As a complement to existing deliverables, CEN and CENELEC are developing a streamlined format tailored specifically to urgent technical or regulatory requirements, e.g. in the ICT sector. These new European Agile Specifications (EAS) can be prepared in a matter of months and still meet requirements of inclusiveness and transparency. All decisions remain consensus oriented in line with the core principles of the ESS.
